Composters— Yard waste and food scraps make up 20% - 30% of garbage!! By composting yard and kitchen waste, you send less garbage to landfills. Flowers, vegetables, trees, shrubs, house plants, lawns, and container gardens grow better in soil mixed with compost. Composting provides an almost constant source of free fertilizer and soil conditioner. Through regular use of compost you can greatly reduce the need for chemical fertilizers, pesticides and herbicides, which saves money and reduces contamination of our waterways and drinking water. Our Composters are made from a black, 55 gallon recycled food



Save the Rain for a Sunny Day! By using rain barrels, you are benefiting the environment by reducing sewer runoff, helping your garden and landscape thrive, reducing your water bill, and reducing stress to the water supply. A rain barrel is a system that collects and store rain-water from your roof. Only 1/4 inch of rainfall runoff from the average roof will completely fill the typical barrel. Because you are collecting it right off your roof, it has few contaminants and is perfect for watering gardens, flower pots, car and window washing.
